Dear Parent / Carers

Re: Temporary Closure of Glenmoor & Winton Academies

As you will be aware, the Government has announced that all schools in England will close temporarily for the vast majority of children from the end of the day on Friday 20 March 2020. This decision has been taken on the advice of medical and scientific experts in order to manage the spread of COVID-19 and relieve pressure on the health system. From Monday 23 March 2020, students' education will continue from home. By the end of this week we will send you specific details of how this will operate. We have prepared well for these circumstances so that all our students can continue their education from home during the closure. I am extremely grateful to all staff across the Academies for the way in which they have taken on this challenge.

The Academy will, however, remain open for two specific groups of students:

- Those whose parents are identified as key workers (employed in the NHS, emergency services or elements of the food supply chain)
- Those who are particularly vulnerable

I would ask that parents who believe they fall into the category of key workers contact the Academy as soon as possible and no later than **12 noon on Friday 20 March 2020** via keyworkers@glenmoorandwinton.org.uk in order that we can arrange for your child to continue to attend school. We will be identifying those students who are in the second category and will be contacting parents and carers separately. If you believe your child falls into this latter category and you have not heard from us by 9.00am on Friday 20 March please contact us on the above email address.

The Government has also decided that no external exams will take place this academic year. Over the coming days, they will announce plans for how those due to sit them this year will be able to gain their qualifications. I know how important this will be for our older students and we will be ensuring that whatever is put in place can be implemented through the school in a way that does not penalise any of our students' places at 6th Form or College. It may be that teacher assessments and predicted grades will be at the heart of the system this year. If so, it is possible that we will need to justify our assessed grades using students' work on paper and in books. For students in Years 11, therefore, while preparation for traditional exams will not be the focus, we are likely still to want to work intensively with them in the coming weeks so that whatever is ultimately assessed for qualifications is representative of each students' best ability.
