Re: Year 7 Homework

In order to ensure workload for students is distributed evenly throughout the week, year 7 students will be set homework for their subjects according to the following homework timetables.

All homework will be set and monitored electronically. Students will be set their maths homework on SparxMaths, English on SparxReader and science on Seneca. Details of how students can login to Sparx and Seneca can be found in the attached PDFs. Alongside core subjects, MFL, geography, history and ethics will set short knowledge based quizzes on a fortnightly basis via Show My Homework. Login information for Show My Homework has been sent previously.

As you can see from the timetable, for each piece of homework there is a day that the homework will be set, a recommended completion day and a day that the homework is due. We would really encourage students to complete homework on the recommended completion day so that workload is spread out and students can engage with each piece of homework to the best of their ability. If needed, students will also be able to discuss with their teachers between the recommended completion day and the day due to allow any issues to be discussed.

Homework detentions will be set for homework that is not completed to the required standard by the due day. This year we are continuing with a compulsory homework club to further support students with independent learning. Specifically, the students that receive multiple homework detentions during a half term will be required to attend compulsory homework club 3 – 4pm Monday to Thursday. During the homework club, students will follow the same timetable as the recommended completion day shown in
